King Henry faces rebellion from the very nobles who helped him seize the crown. The insurgents boast the daring warrior Hotspur - while Prince Hal, the King's son and England's greatest hope, carouses in the Boar's Head Tavern with Shakespeare's greatest comic creation, Sir John Falstaff.

### **Tartuffe, or The Imposter**

**By Molière**

*Tartuffe* is one of Molière's most entertaining and timeless works. Orgon, the head of a prosperous family, has taken in and been taken in by Tartuffe, a man who purports to be holy, but is really an imposter. Orgon and his mother are the only ones to have fallen under the trickster's spell - the rest of Orgon's relatives, including his wife and brother-in-law, see right through Tartuffe.

### **Of Thee I Sing**

**Music by George Gershwin, lyrics by Ira Gershwin,  
book by George S. Kaufman & Morrie Ryskind**

A political satire focusing on the election campaign and presidency of John P. Wintergreen. With no viable platform he runs simply on love.
